## **Newsletter: February 2024**

### Funding for 2, 3 and 4 year olds.

We are still waiting to hear from KCC about the rates of funding they will pay nurseries and the terms and conditions we will need to adhere to claim it.

The government made the announcement to the parents many months ago, but our Local Authority have still not yet confirmed what rate they will be paying the nursery for the 2 -,3- & 4-year-olds. At the moment they pay £4.85 per hour per child, (around 50% less than our average hourly rate) for the 3-5-year-olds which means the nursery subsidises the rest.

If the new funding rates do not meet the rising costs, then the nursery could not remain sustainable, hence why so many nurseries are forced to close. We have heard this week of two nurseries from a large chain close by that are closing at the end of March.

As always, if we can deliver parents the rate in a way that keeps us sustainable, then of course we will.

We have been chasing the Local Authority for news about this as some parents have already asked and we will, of course, let you know as soon as we know more.

We aim to send out letters of our delivery of funded hours by mid-February. In the meantime, you can go onto www.childcarechoices.gov.uk to see if your child is eligible for the new 15 hours funding for 2 year old's or the 30 hours for the 3-5 year

If your child is eligible, please let us know and we will email you a parental declaration form to complete the and bring it in the office, but this cannot be done until the week of the 19th February 2024.
